



Who can receive a Bob Box?

If you are age 65 or older, answering “YES” to ANY of these questions means: **You qualify for a Bob Box.**

- Are you a senior citizen who experiences times when it is difficult to buy food?
- Are there times when you have very little or no food in your home?
- Do you wonder where your next meal will come from because you have no money to purchase food?
- Are you on a fixed income and have to make the difficult choice between purchasing food, medications, or other essential supplies / services?

Bob Boxes are designed for senior citizens who do not have food to eat. They are a safety net provided by the Kansas Food Bank, sponsored and endorsed by Senator Robert Dole. They are specifically meant to assist seniors who would rather go without before they would ever ask for help. A Bob Box is a “Hand Up....not a Hand Out”.

To be good stewards of our donor’s dollars, we do need to ensure that the Bob Boxes are getting into the hands of our seniors who need them the most.



A Bob Box is not meant to:

- Supplement someone’s pantry so they do not have to grocery shop.
- Replace the local food pantry or commodity distributions.
- Be a free hand out just because someone is over age 65.
- Be an entitlement.
