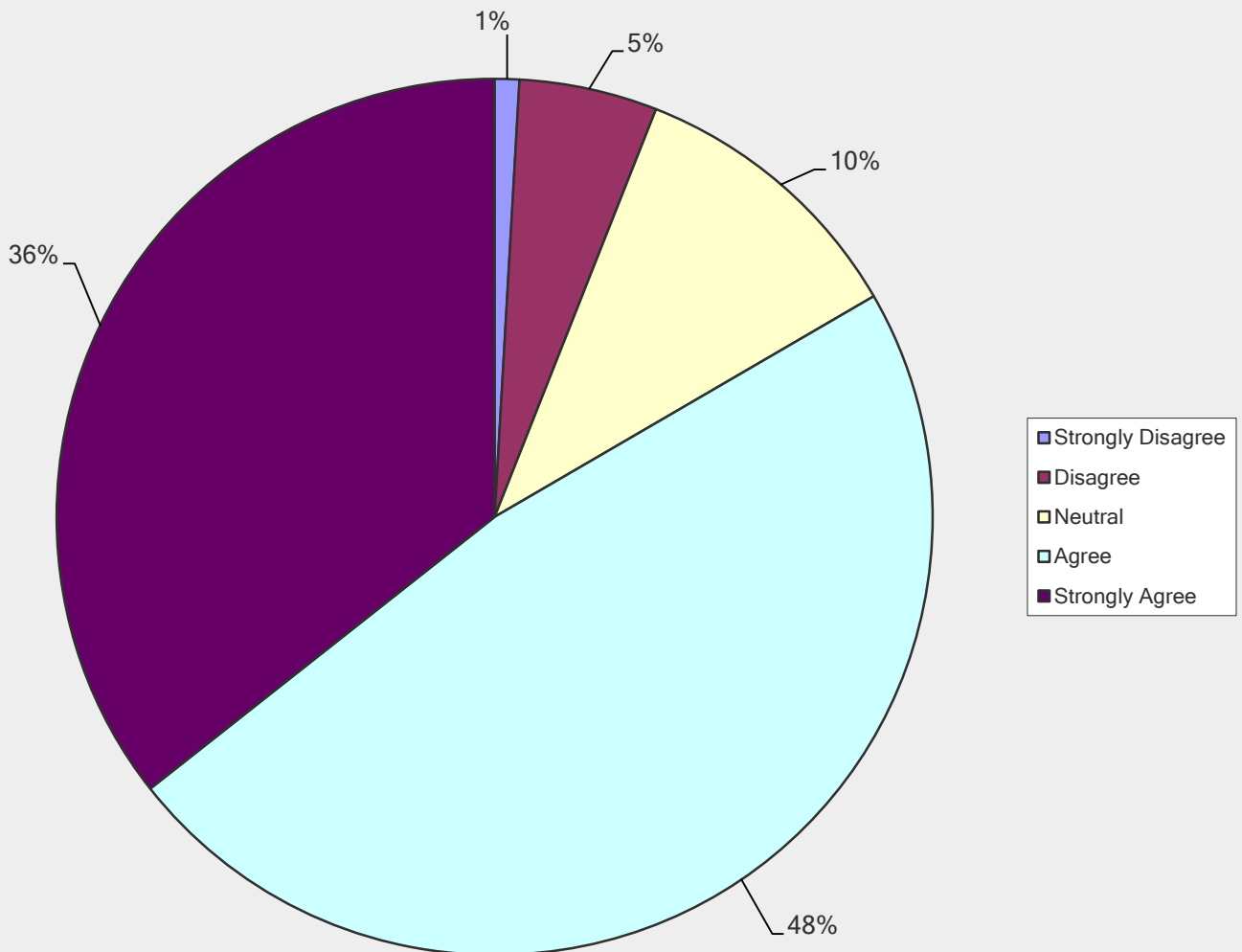

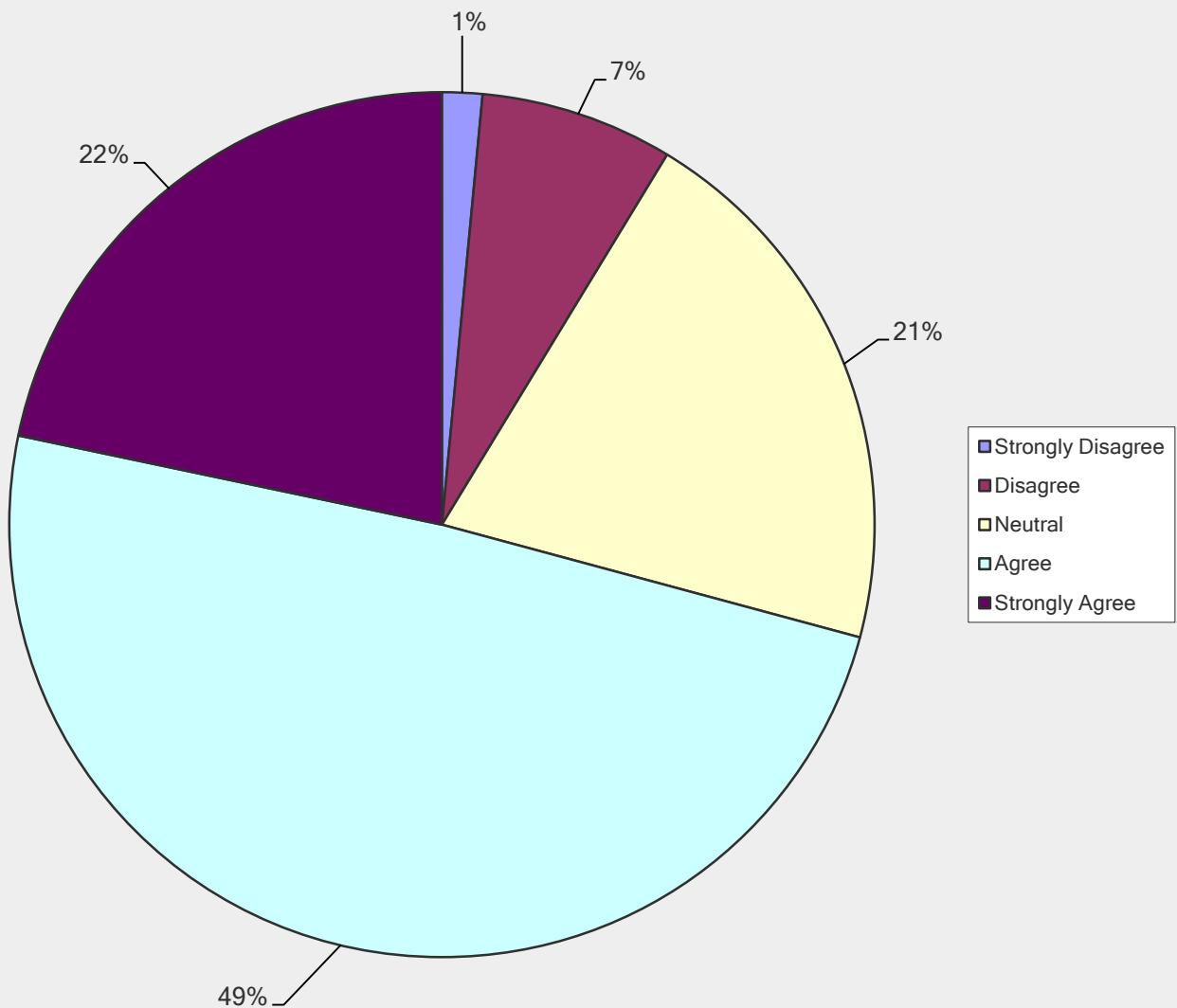

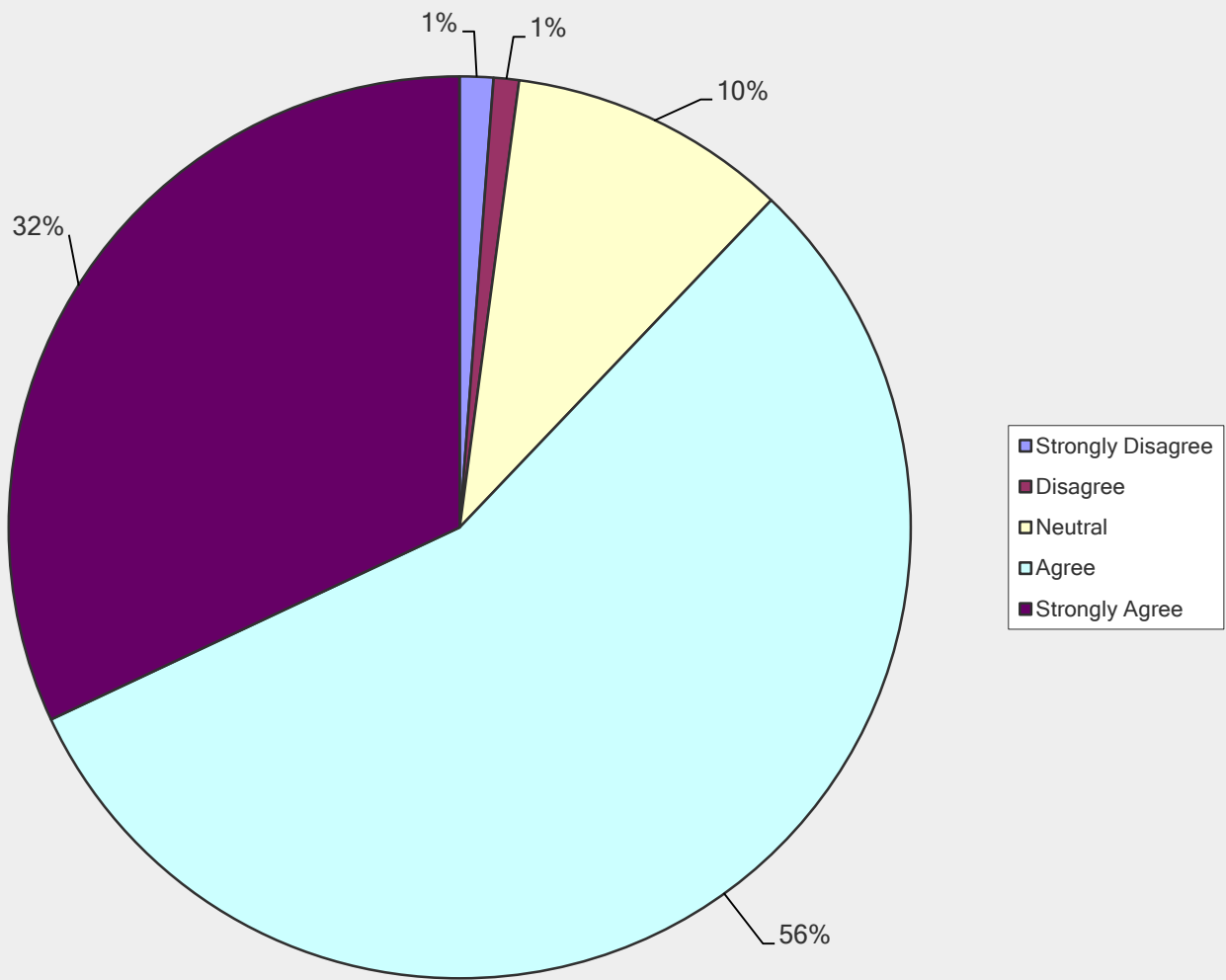

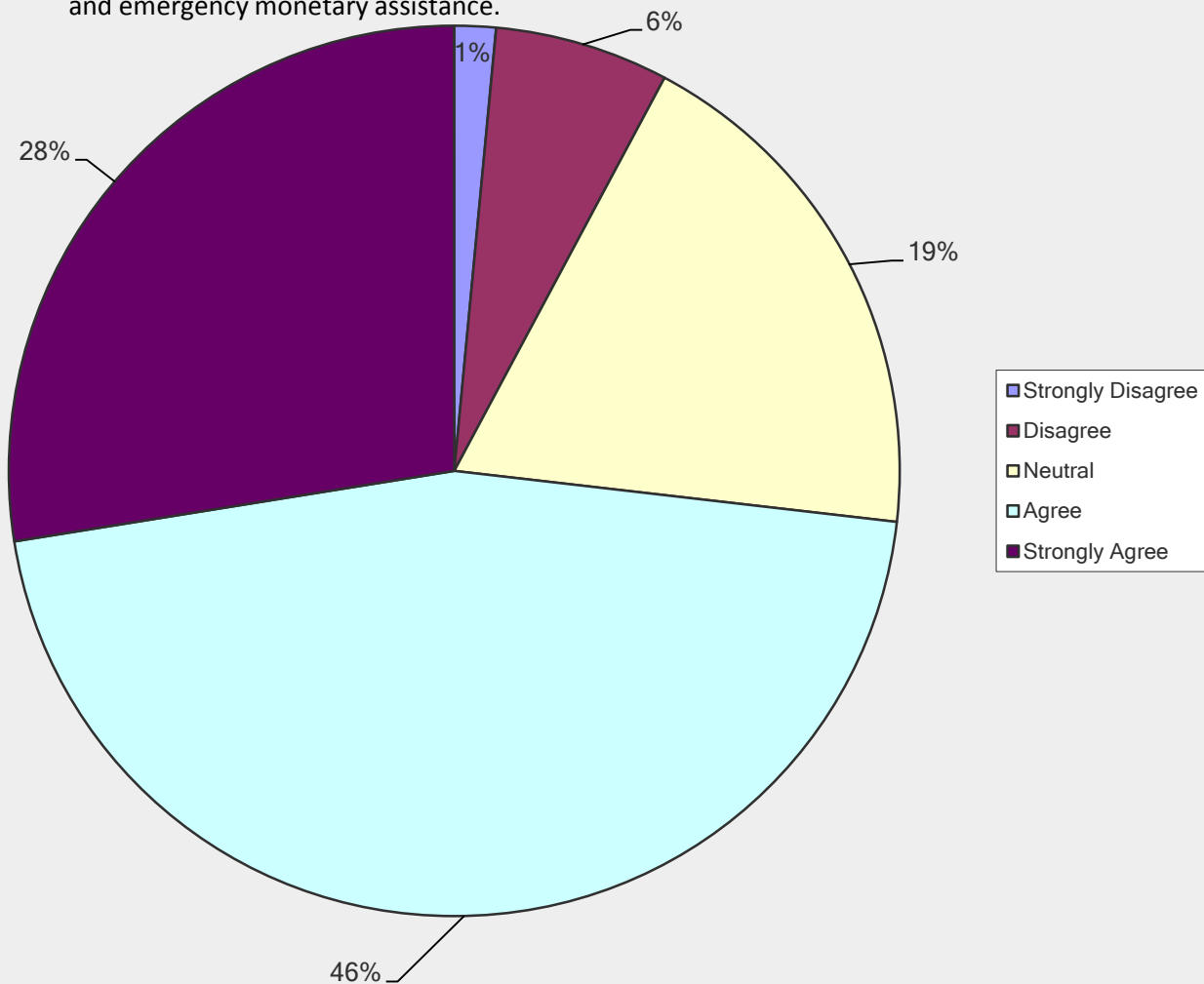

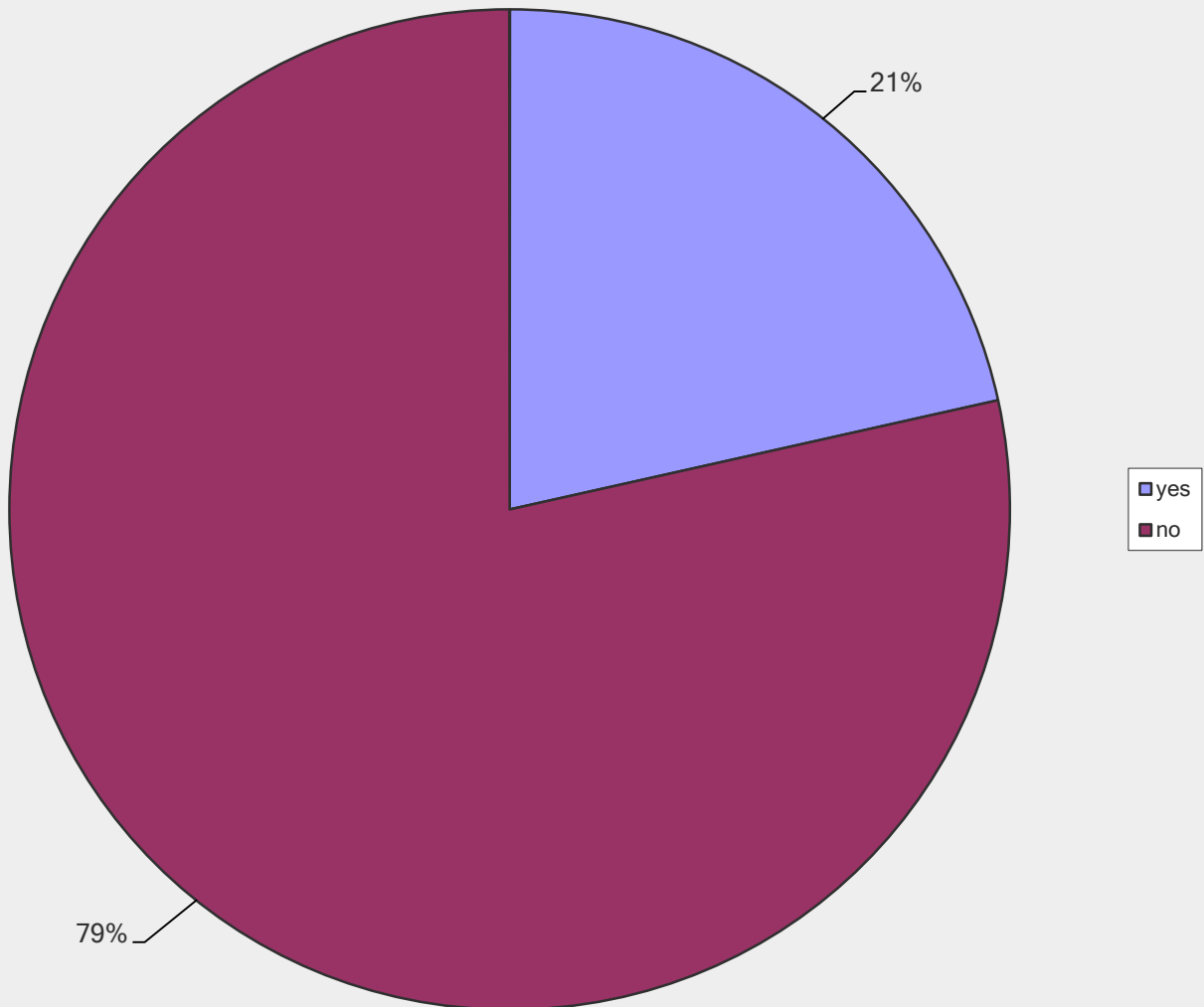

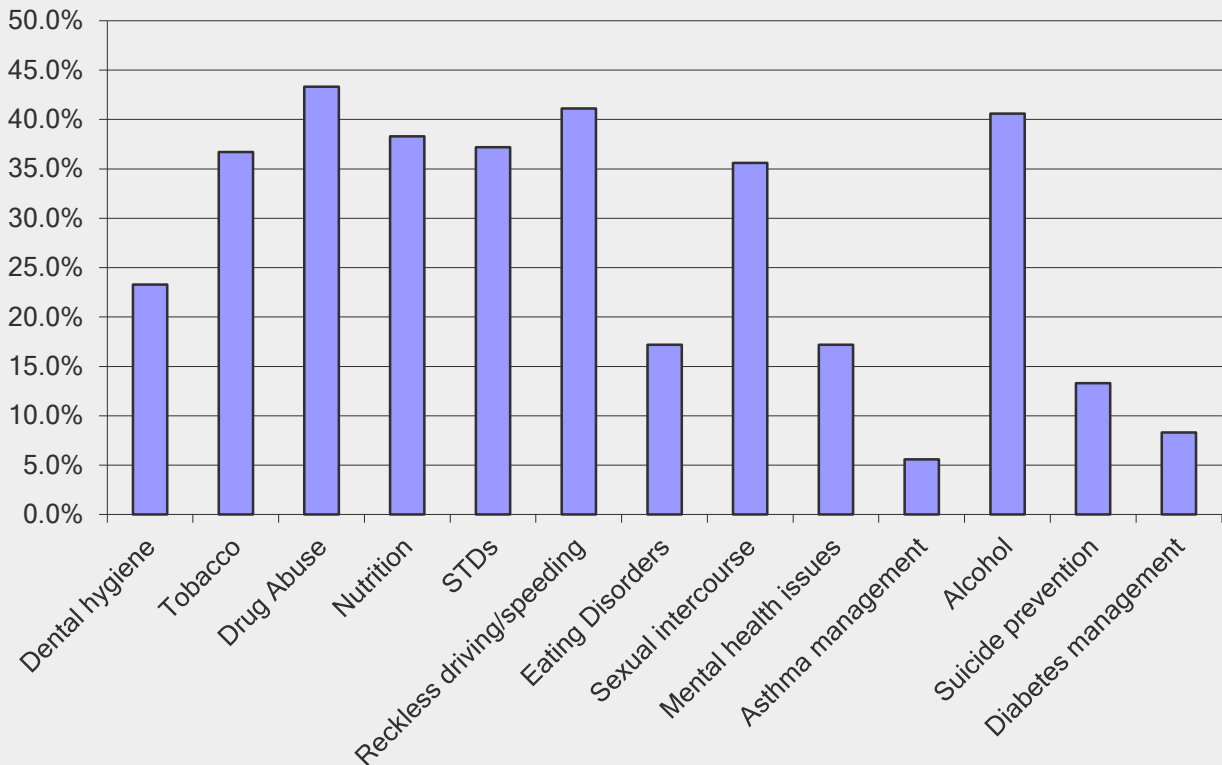

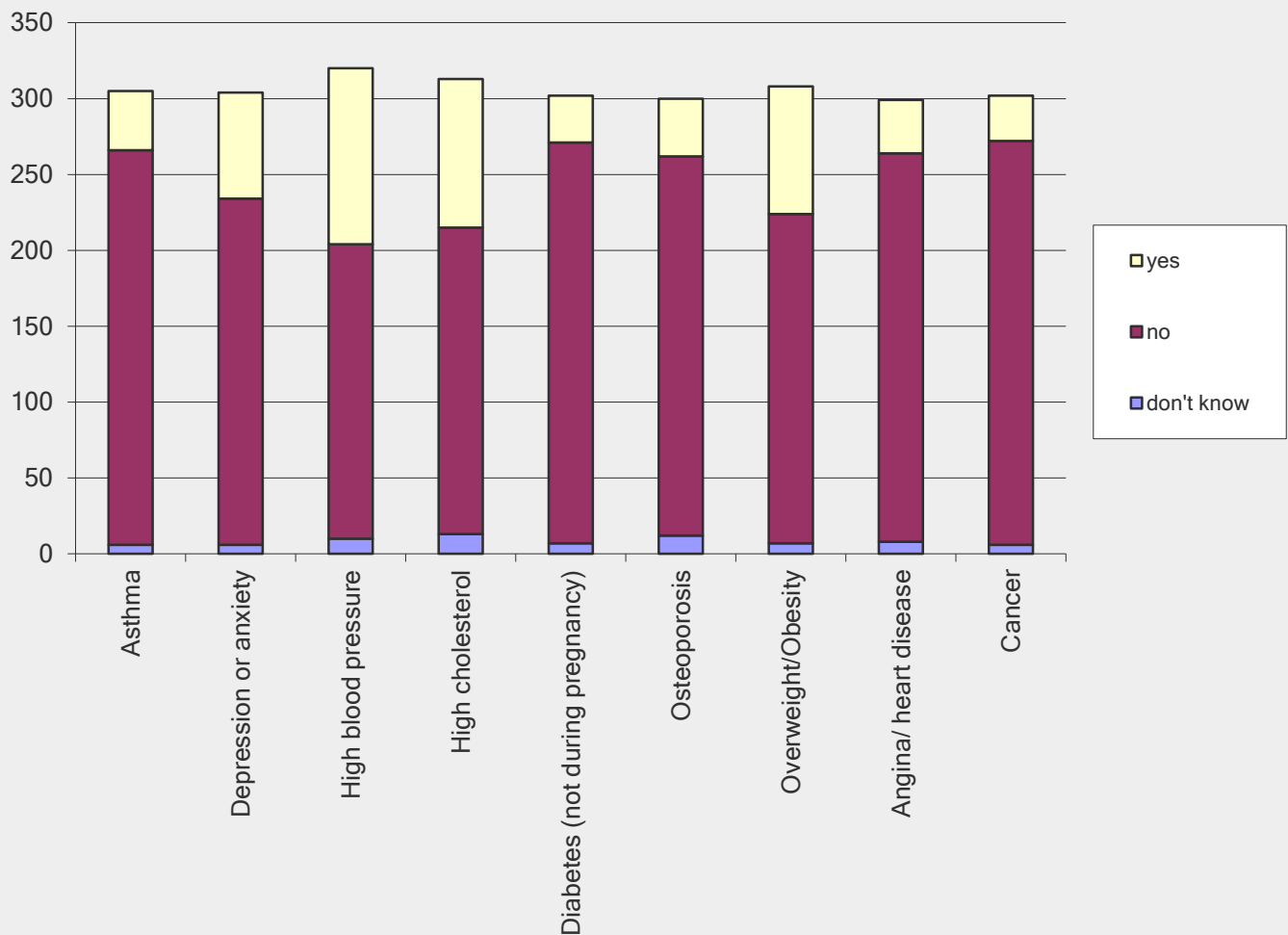

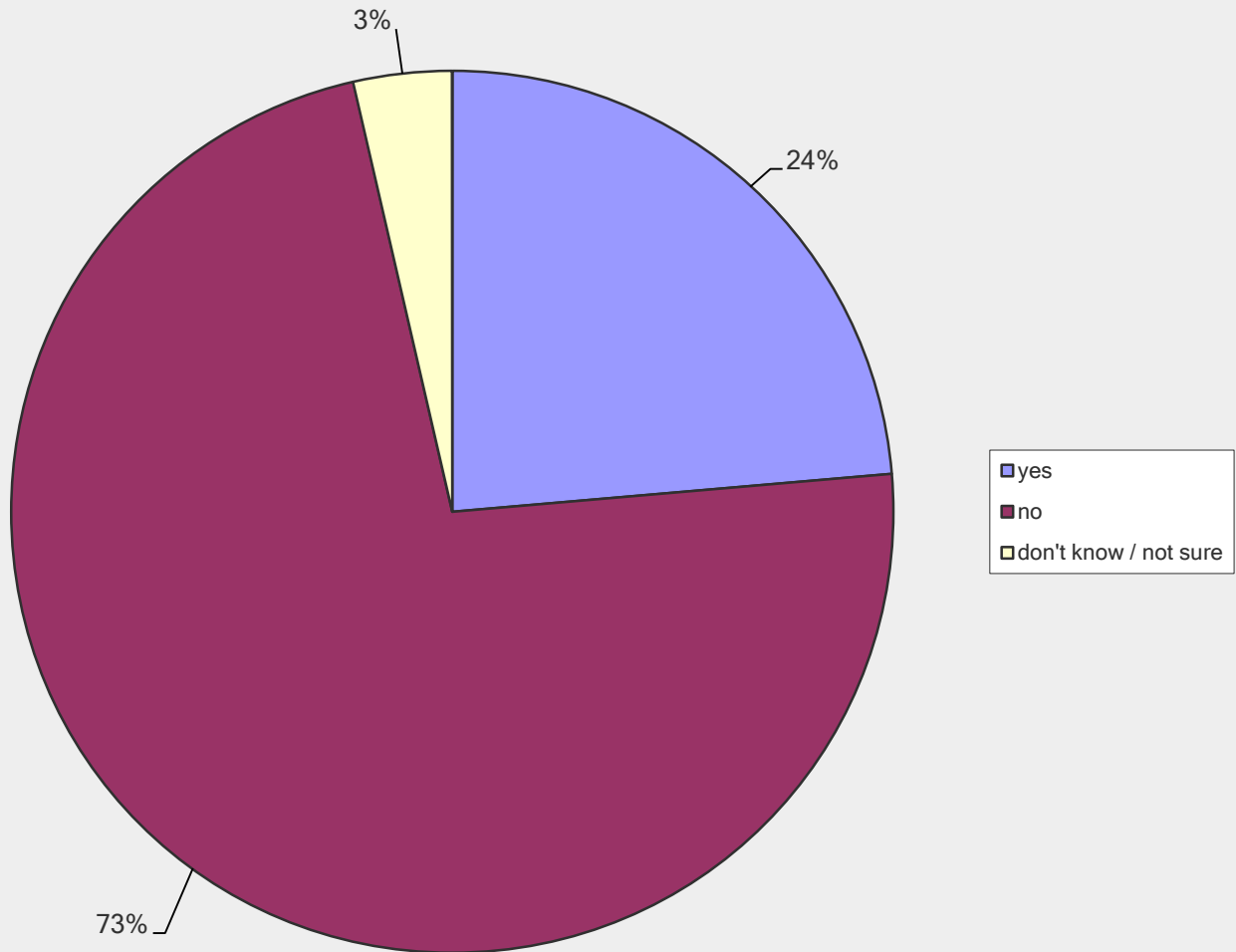

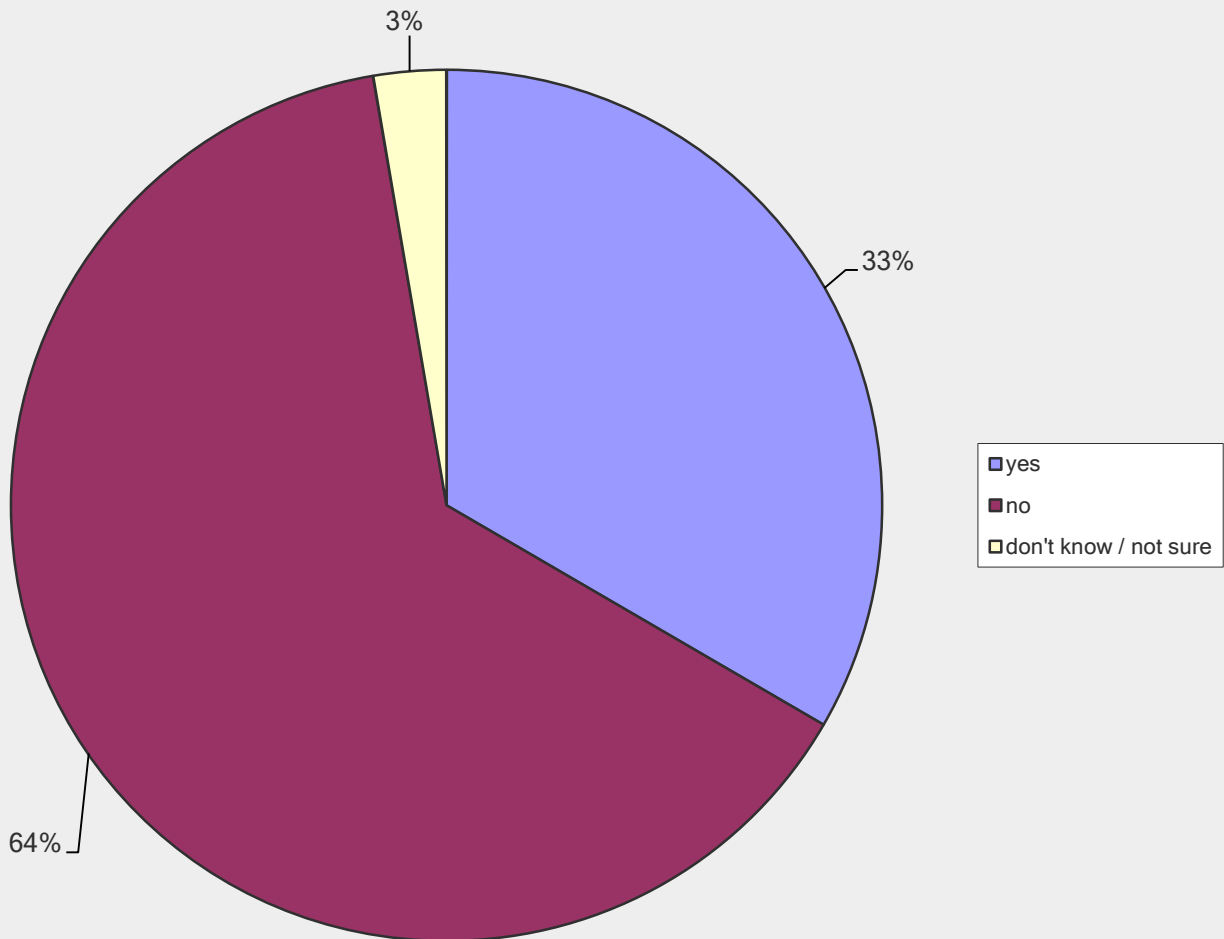

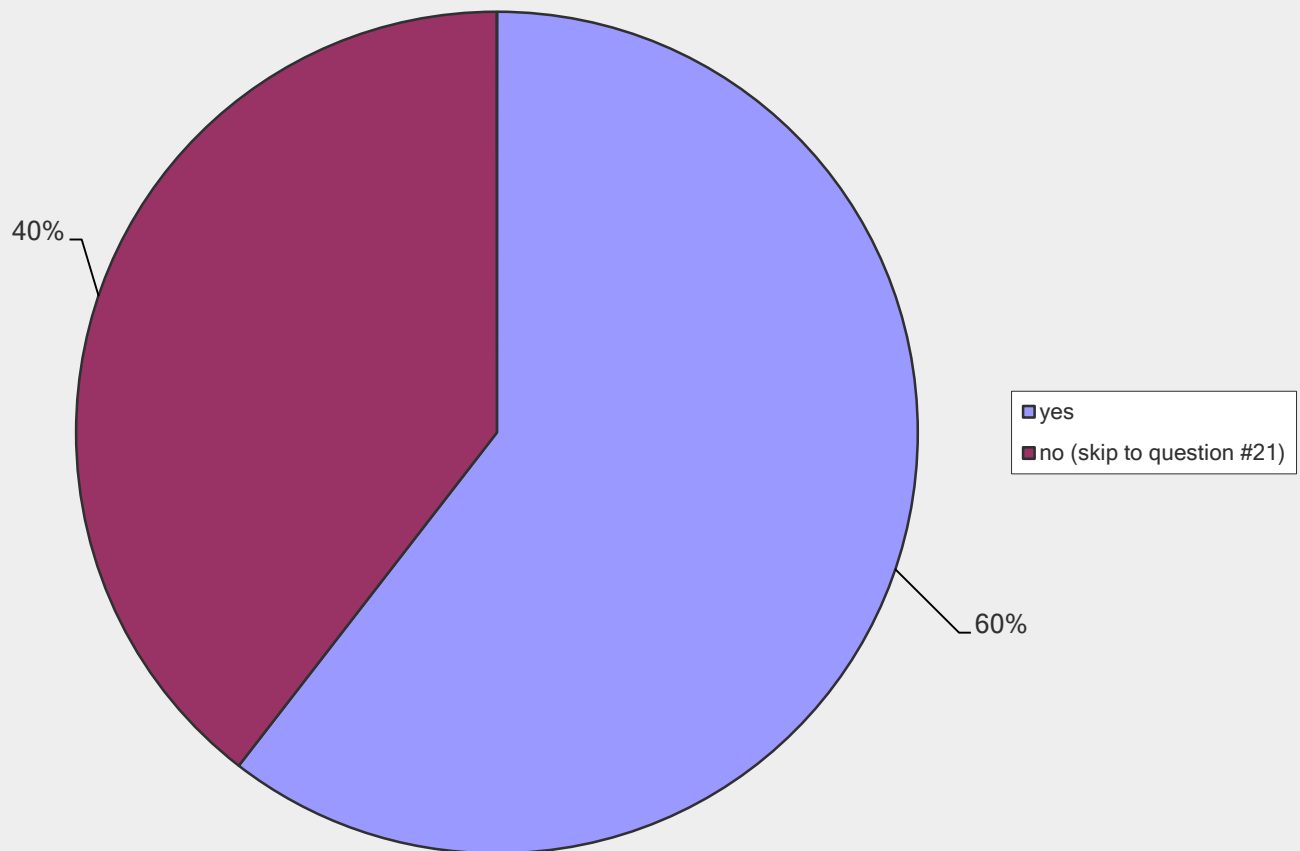

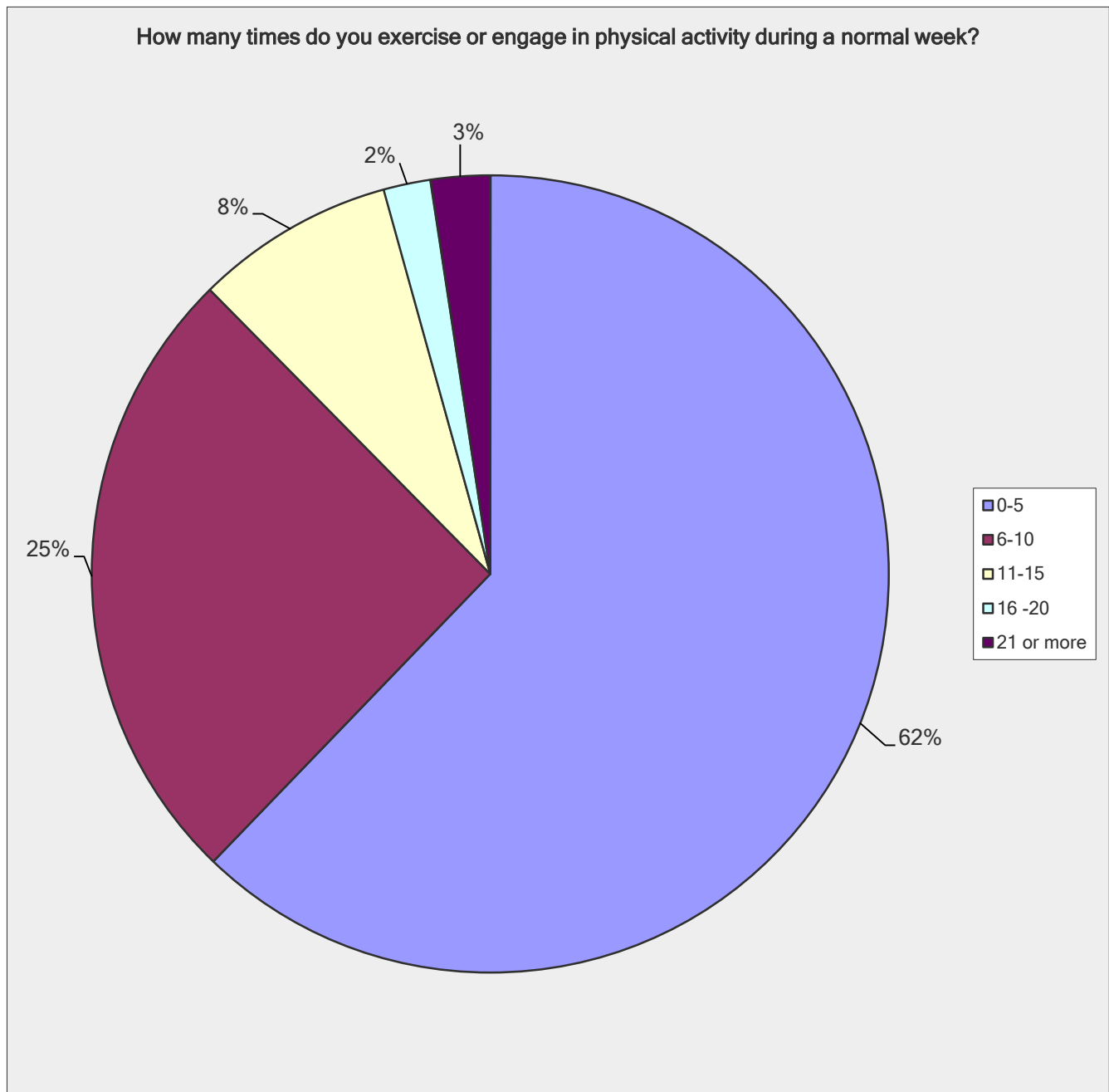

How many times do you exercise or engage in physical activity during a normal week?

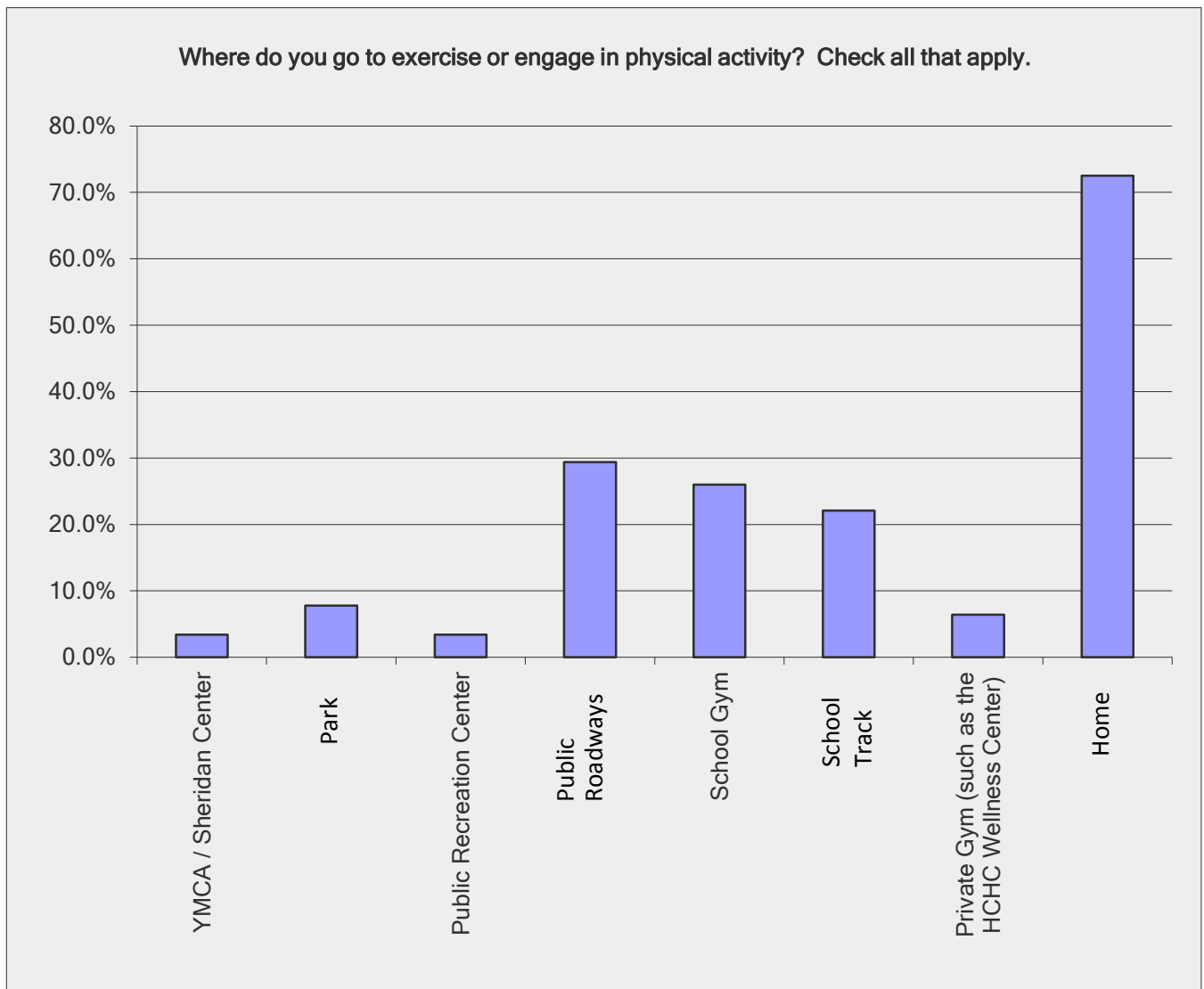

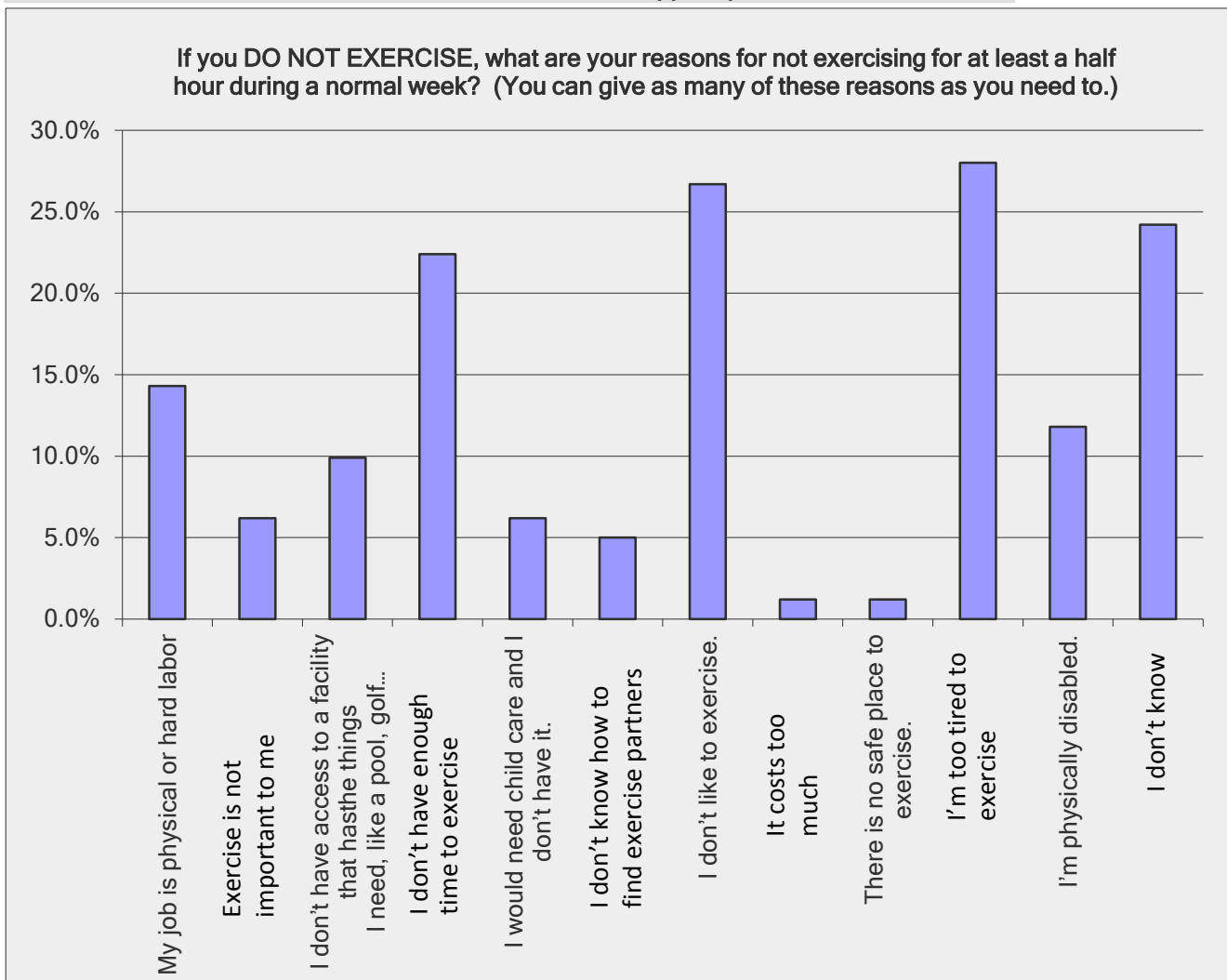

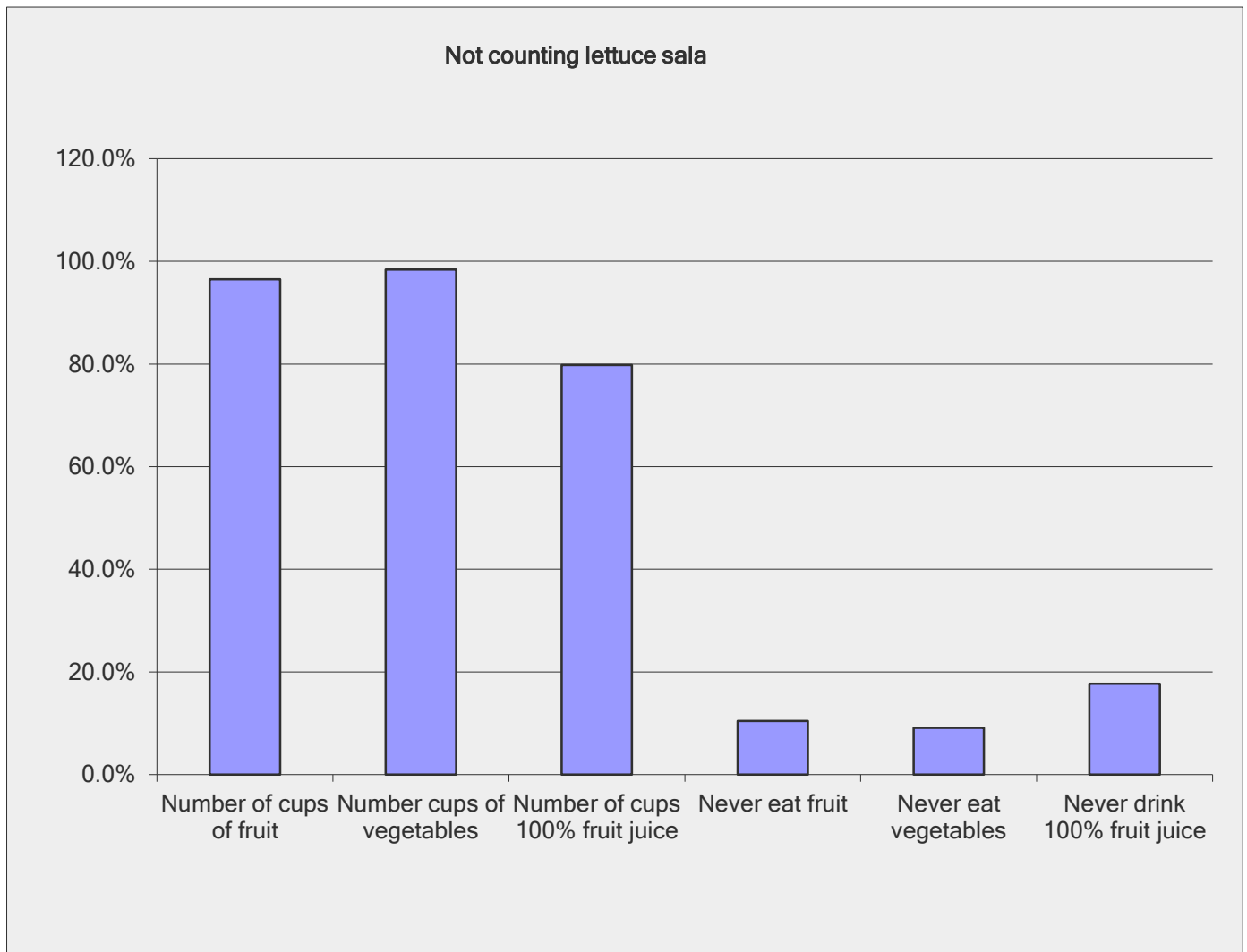

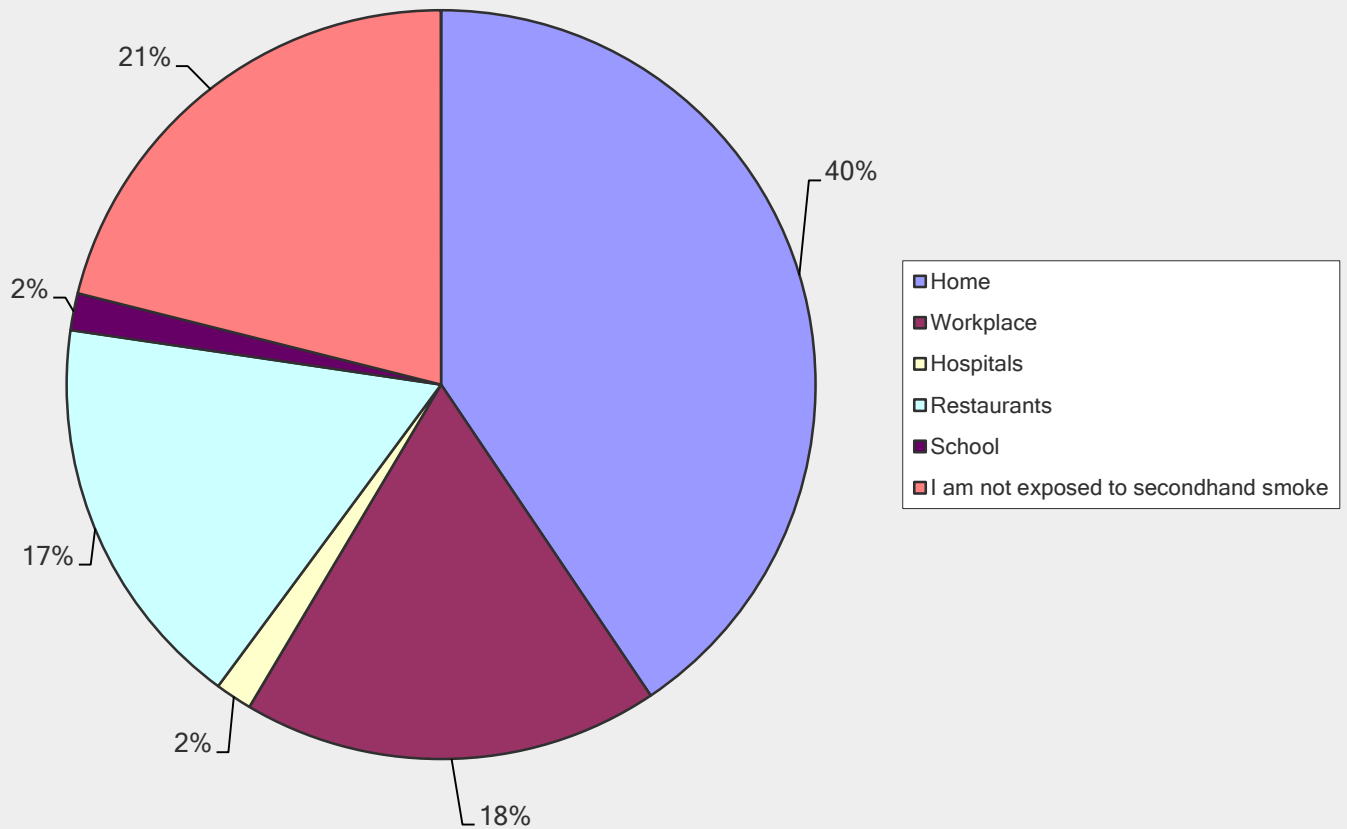

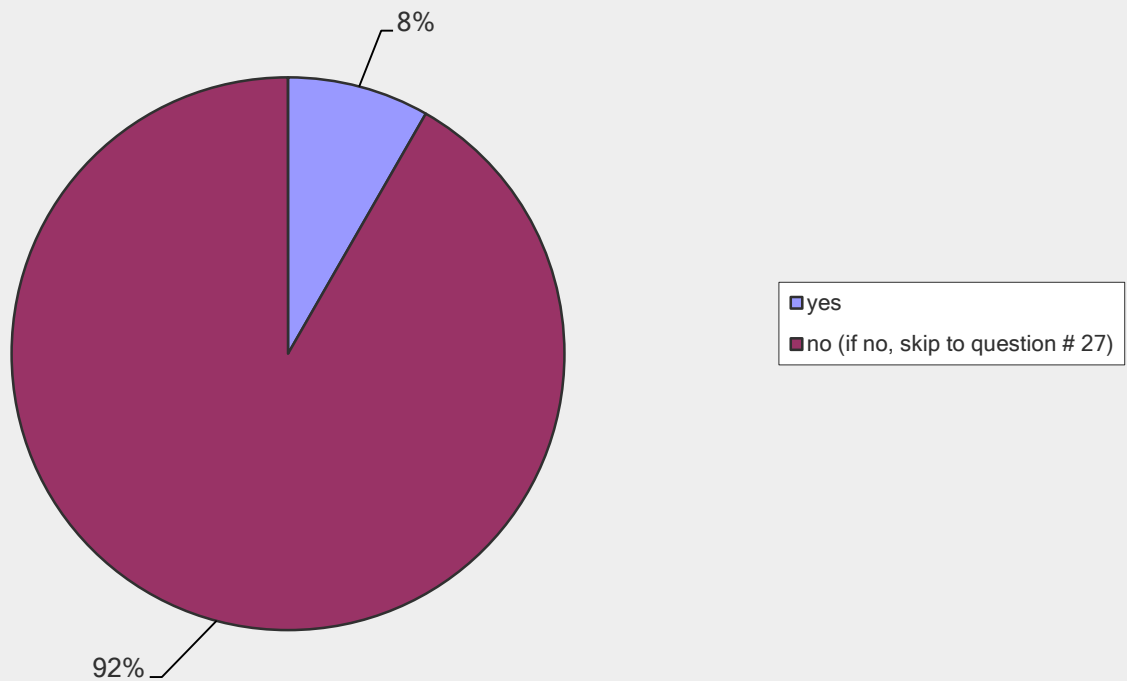

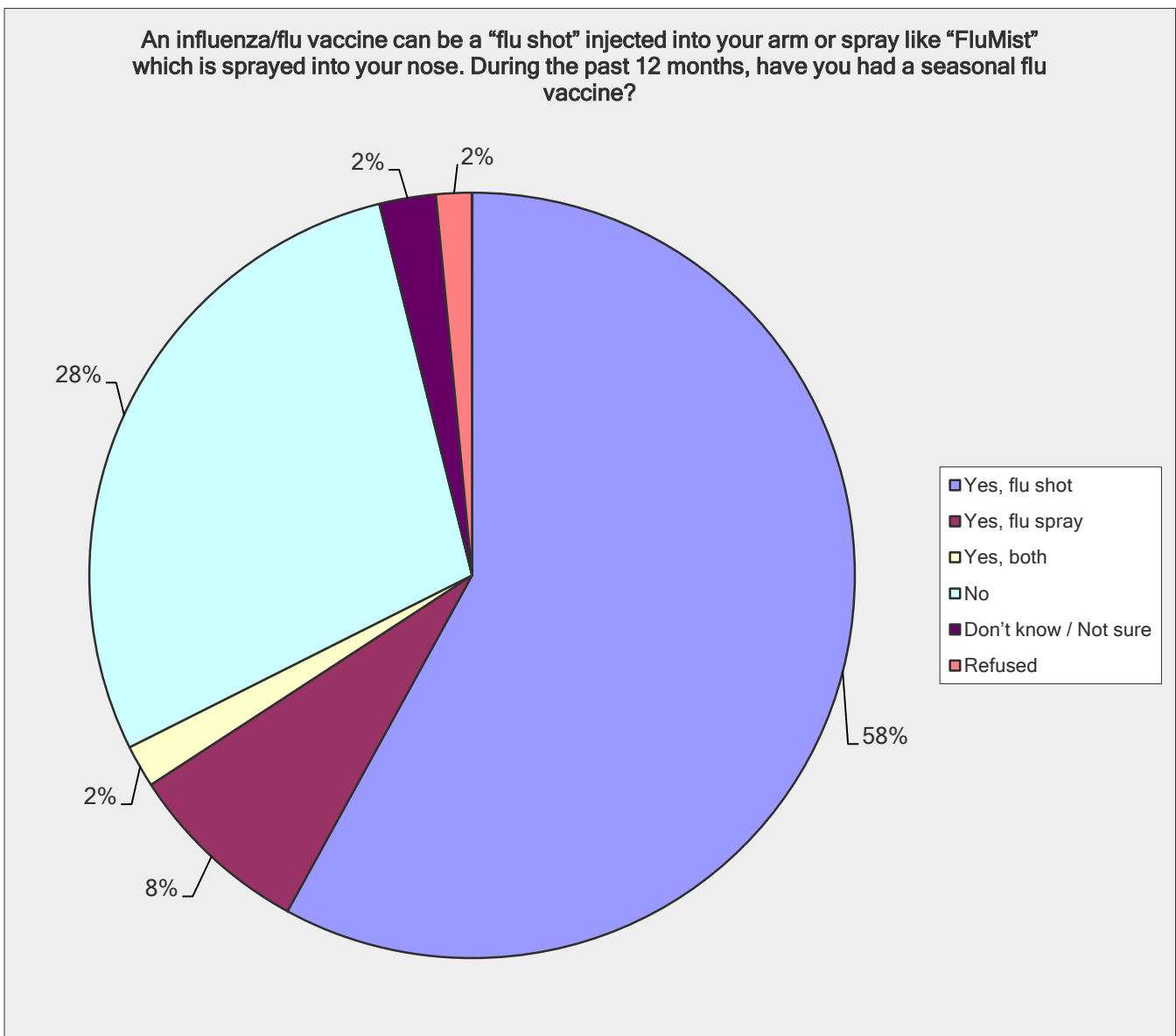

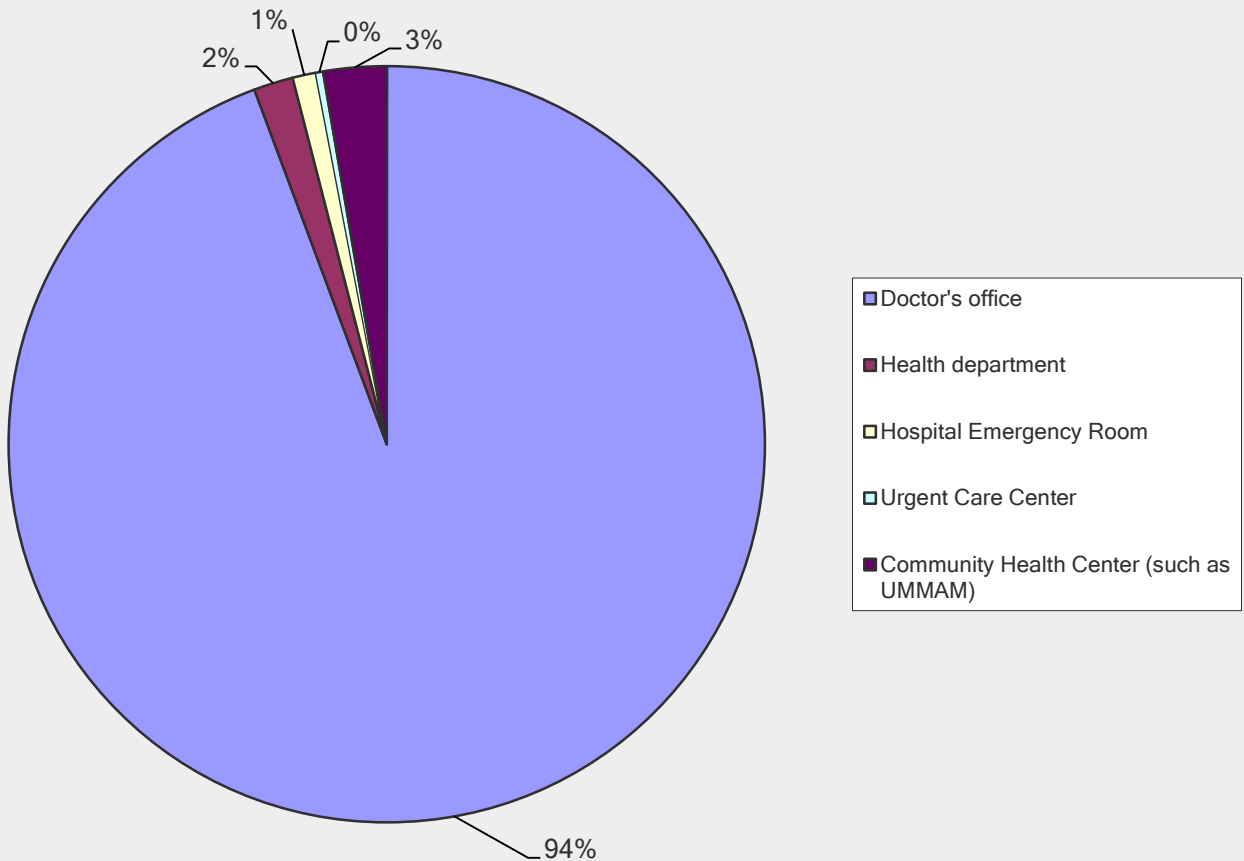

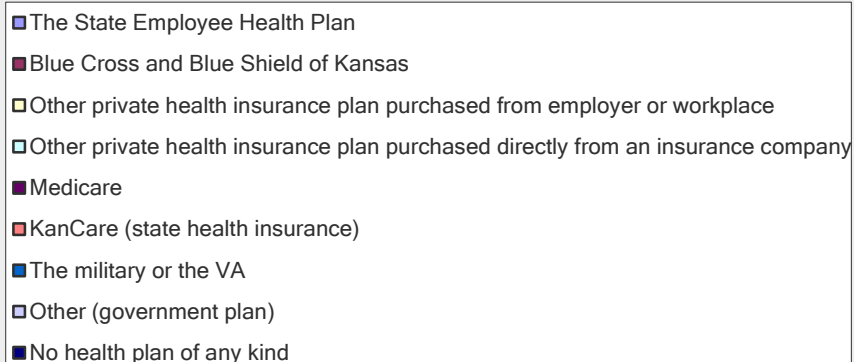

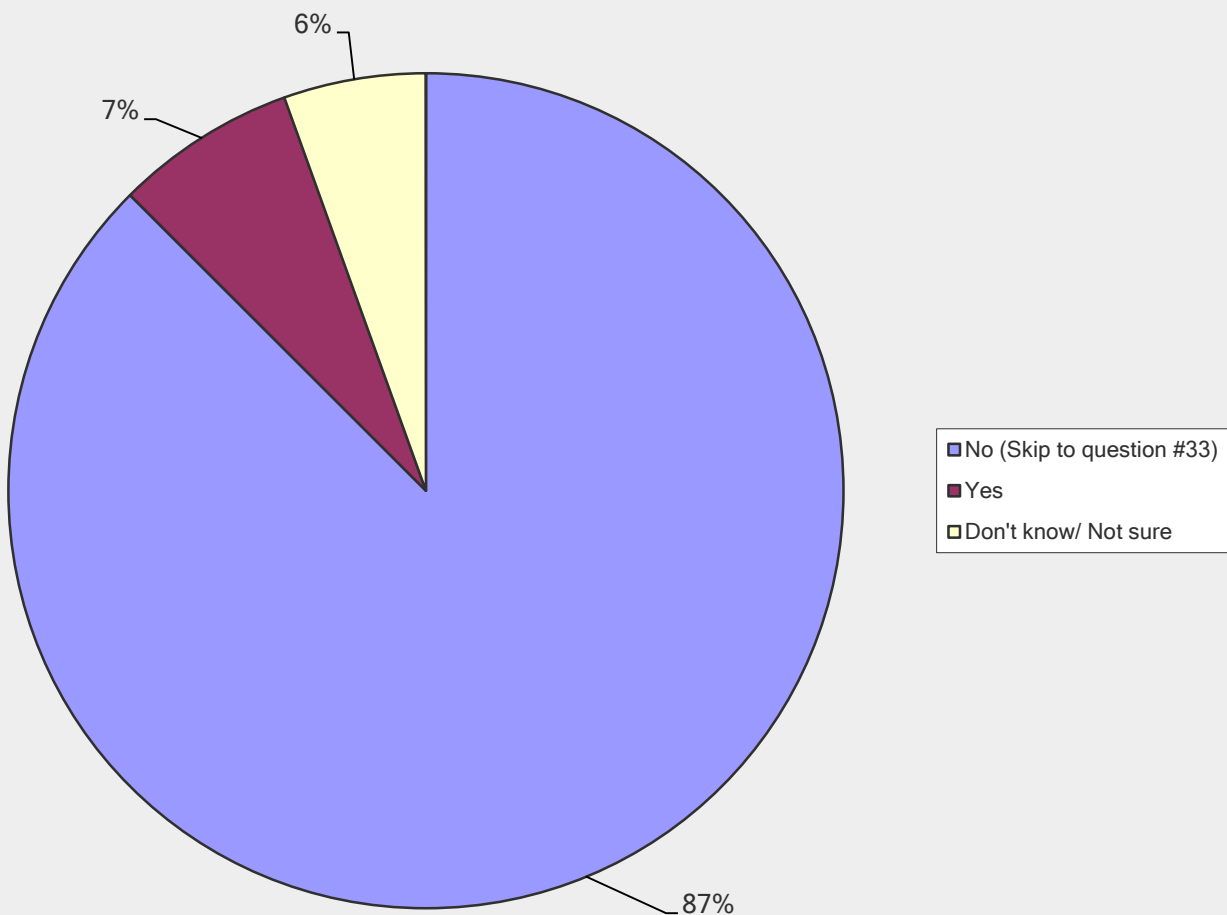

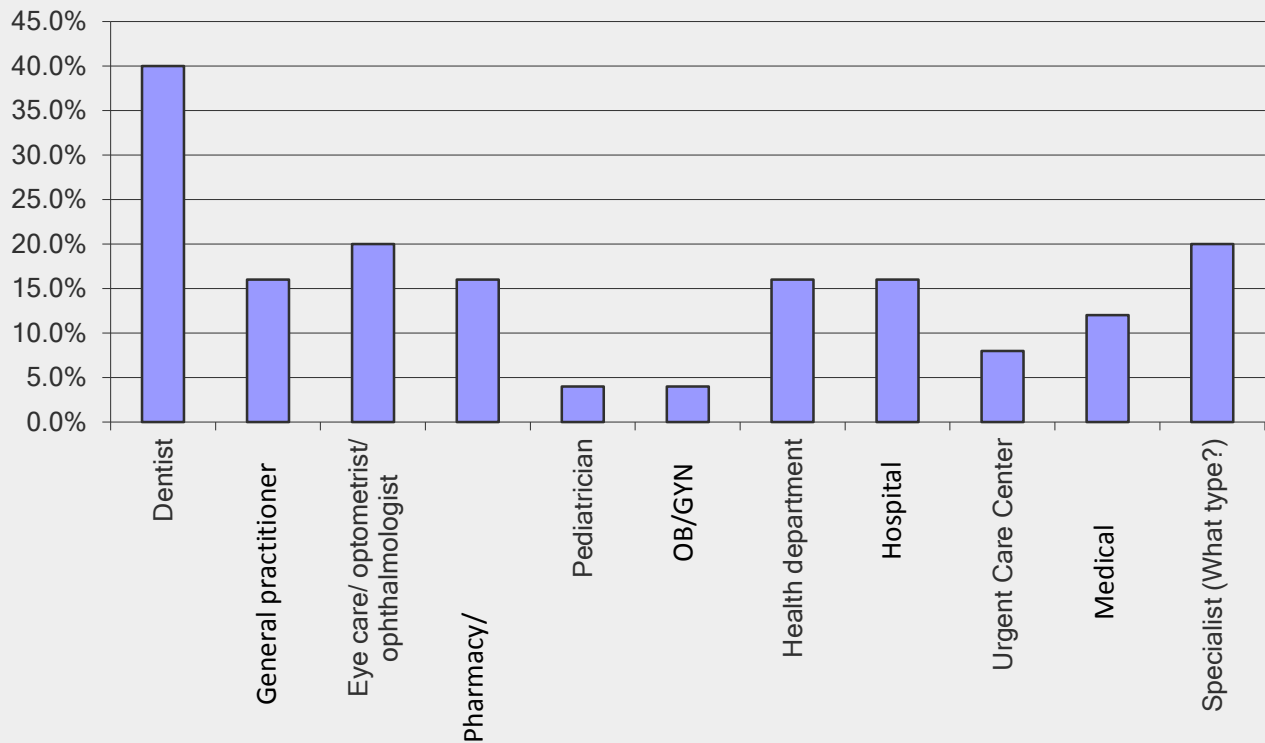

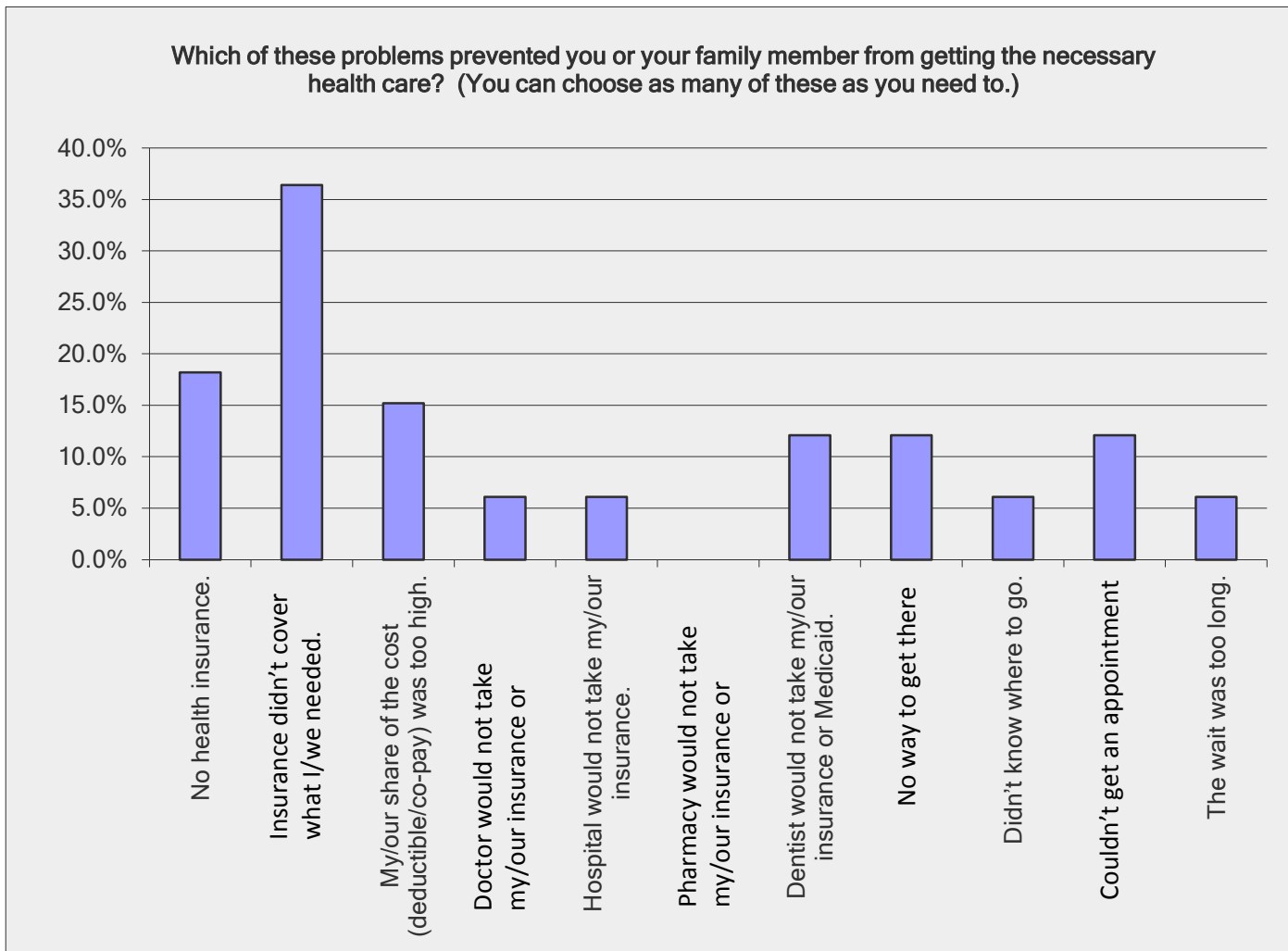

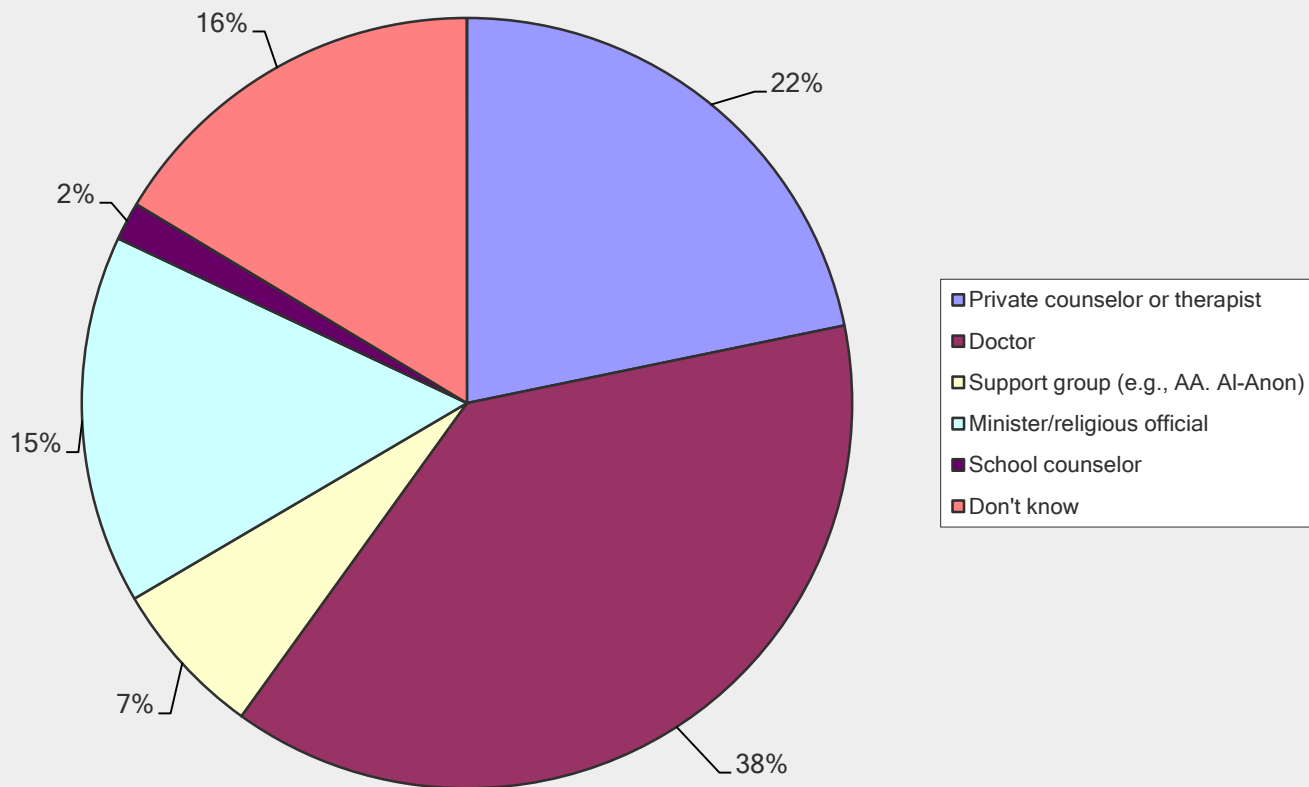

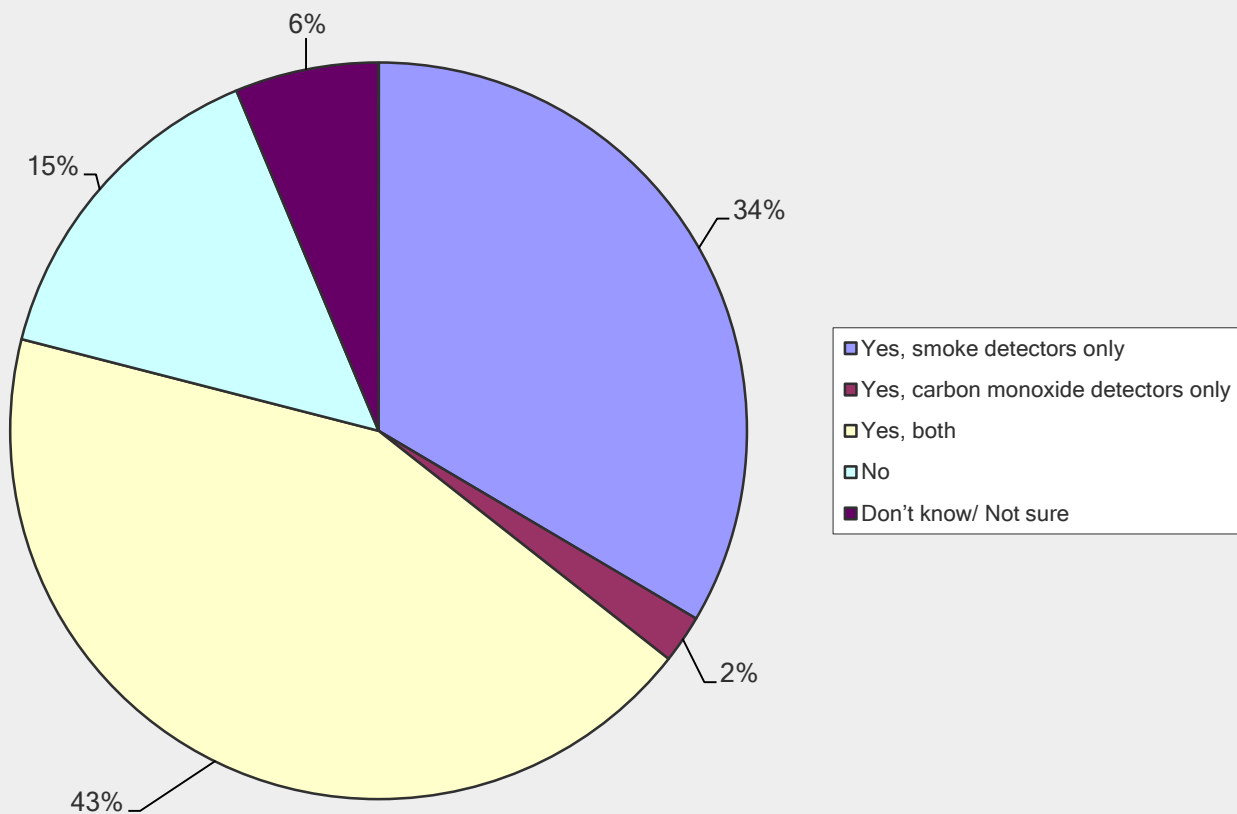

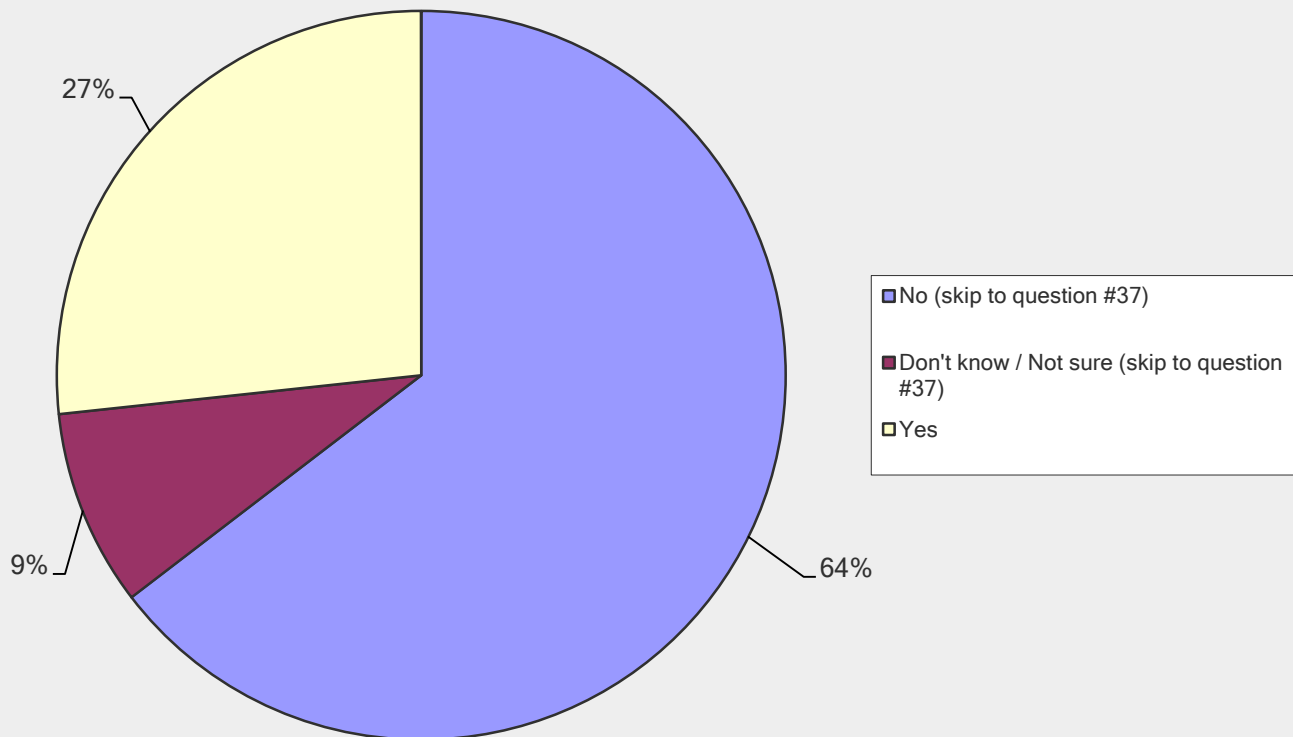

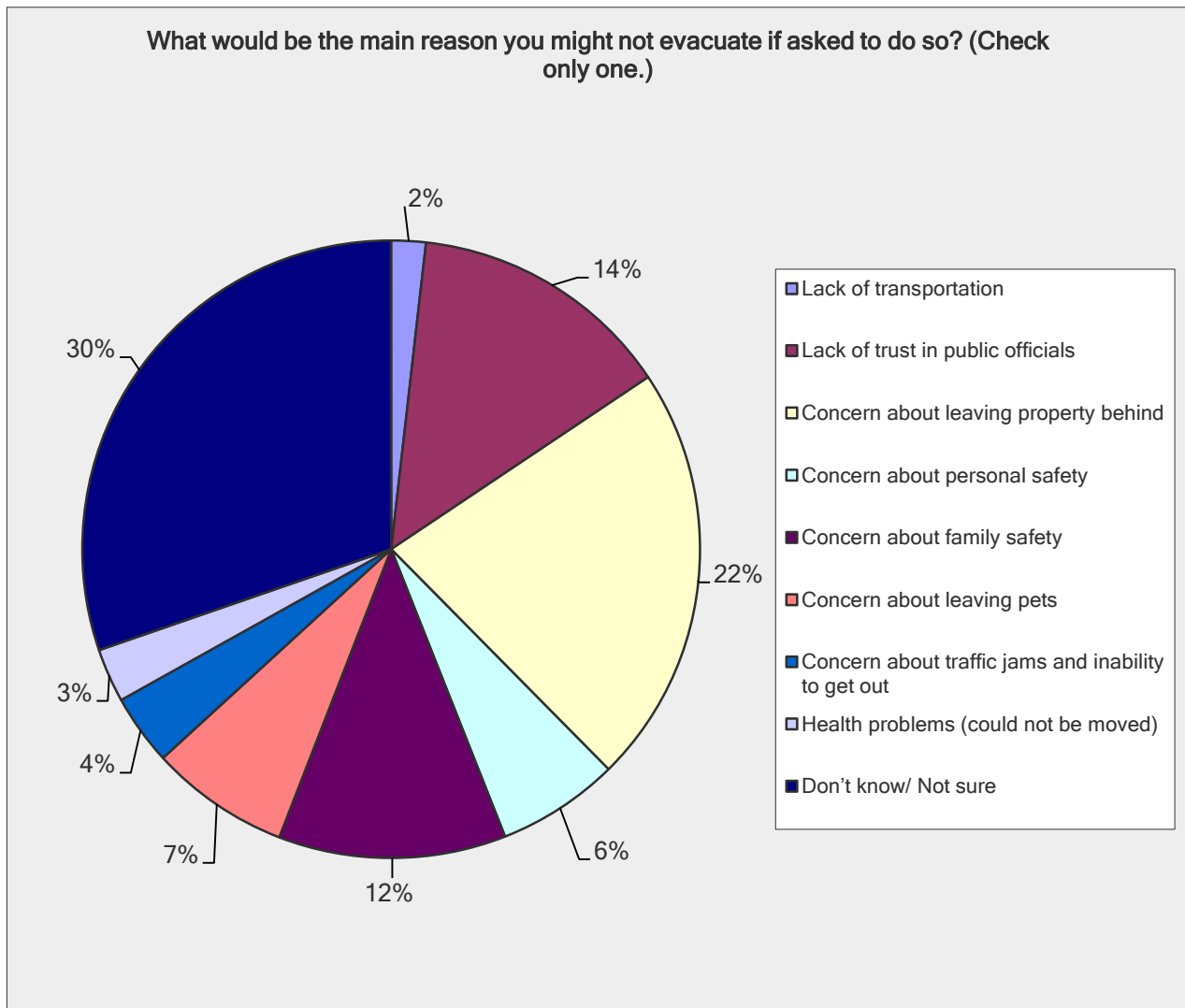

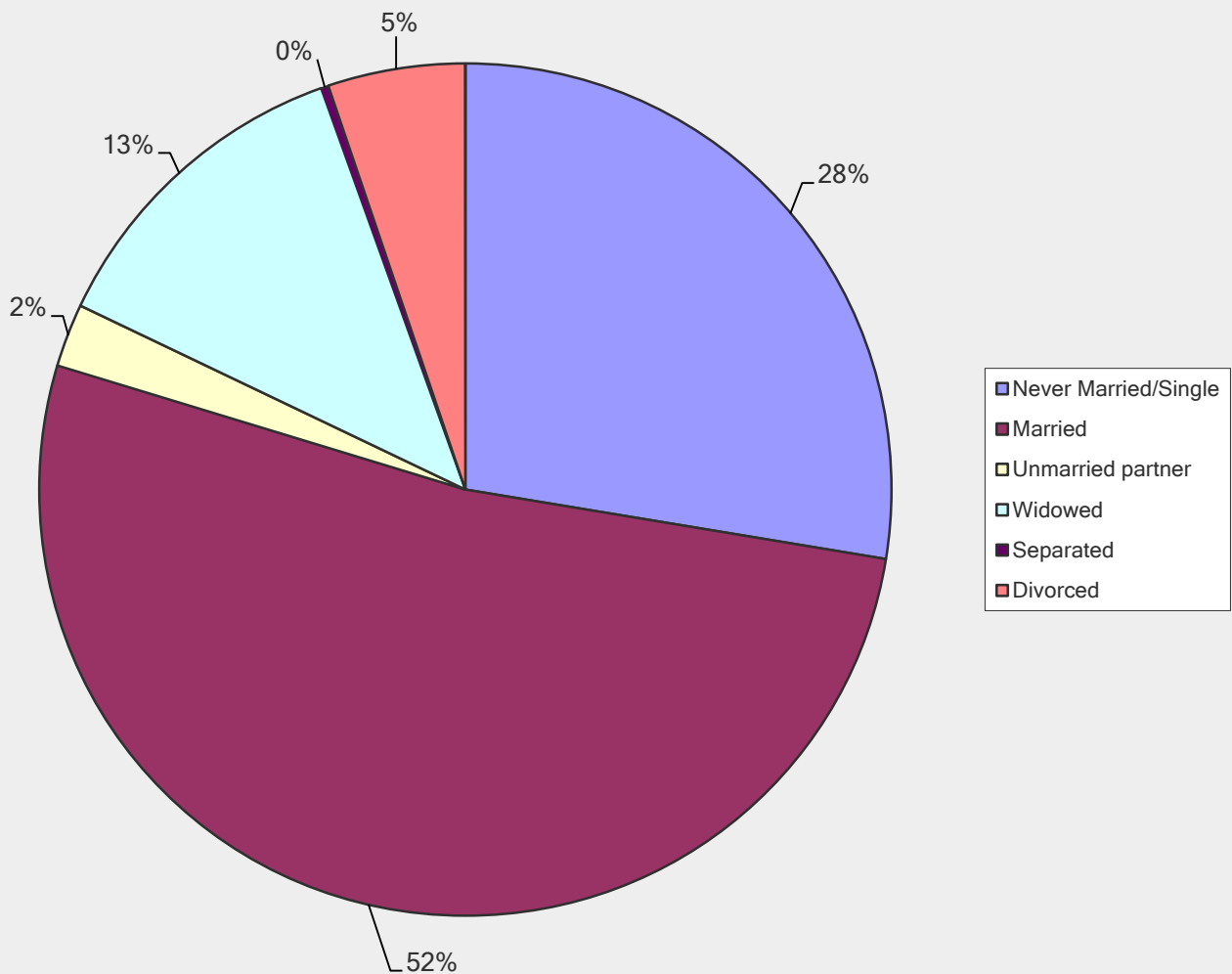

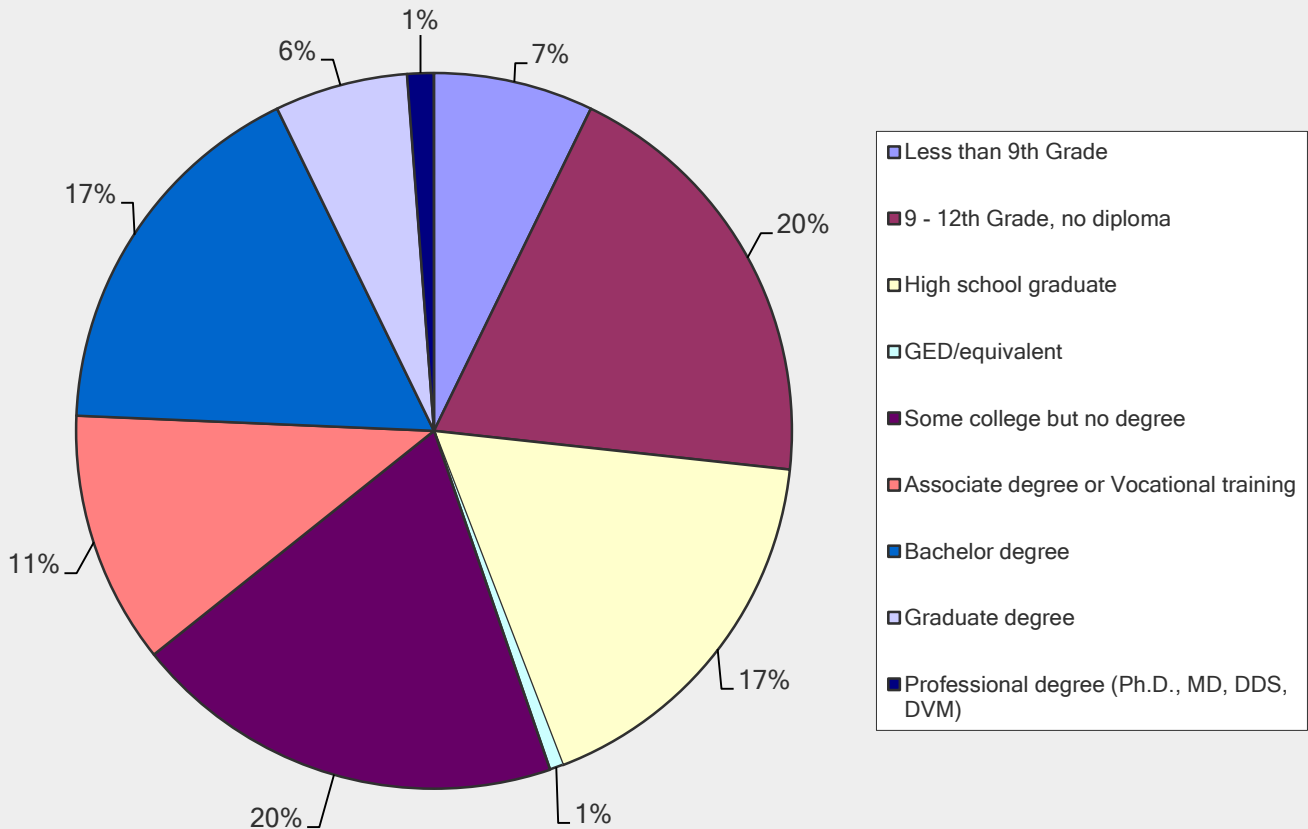
